## Agenda Item 1: Brief Round of Introductions (Pablo)

- Since this was the 1st Steering Committee (SC) meeting organized by Global Cyber Alliance (GCA), a brief round of introductions was performed.
- GCA representatives are listed next:
  - Leslie Daigle is the organization's CTO and the Director of the Internet Integrity (I2) Program.
  - Andrei Robachevsky is the I2 Technical Director.
  - Alejandro Fernández-Cernuda is the I2 Director of Engagement.
  - Pablo López-Aguilar is the I2 Business and Operations Associate Director, and the secretary of the SC.

## Agenda Item 2: Transition Activities (Pablo)

- At present, most of the transition activities have been accomplished (i.e., mailing lists, domains, Observatory, Telescope, ROA Stats, source code for MANRS components, technical documentation, etc.).

## Agenda Item 3: 2023 MANRS Reports (Kevin)

- Kevin presented the 2023 MANRS Report that summarizes the main highlights for MANRS 2023. The total number of participants at the end of the year was 1073, with 195 having joined the project during the last twelve months. The report also gives details on the number of new participants that have joined the project over the year: 905 Network Operators, 134 IXPs, 28 CDN and Cloud Providers, and 6 Equipment Vendors. The number of Community Meetings organized during the year was five.

## Agenda Item 4: 2024 Comms Plan (Alejandro)

- The Comms Plan is divided into 3 groups, namely Engagement, Target Audiences, and Tools. It was stated that GCA partners might be interested in MANRS and willing to support the project. Hence, GCA will explore these mutual synergies always considering its mission.
- Since most people in the meeting were familiar with ISOC and maybe less with GCA, Alejandro briefly presented the organization.

## Agenda Item 5: 2024 Event Landscape (Alejandro)

- For the MANRS Community Meeting, GCA aims at two in-person meetings. Confirmed events where MANRS will have representation are NANOG 90, M3AAWG 60, and APRICOT (a representative from ISOC will attend).
- The input of the SC members on the events would be always highly valuable. In this context, GCA is conscious of the need to plan in advance the Community Meetings to give time to the members to plan their travel and organize the meeting appropriately.
- It was stated that keeping the Community Meetings more virtual but still having the opportunity to (physically) meet if people are around, was worthwhile.
- The attendance to related events by the MANRS representative might open new opportunities.



- Once ISOC confirms the events for 2024, a calendar will be shared with GCA.

## Agenda Item 6: Any other Business

- Leslie proposed a MANRS lightning talk at NANOG.
- Andrew and Warrick will be attending the Internet2 Tech Exchange in September.
